

Welcome Address

Welcome to all of the participants at this tropical root crop symposium. The International Potato Center (CIP) is very pleased to host this conference and to have the potato included in the concerns of this society.

The commodities being addressed by this society will have to be given greater attention in the future as population growth makes increasing demand on the use of marginal land. The size of farms is already decreasing in Asia, leading to more intensive use of land. Many of the tuber-root crops have a comparative advantage over cereals in intensive agriculture.

Until now, the nutritional value of most tuber-root crops has not received sufficient attention. Their value is well known but has not been publicized, and all too frequently the tuber-root crops have been classified as only starchy foods. The value of their vitamins, minerals, and even protein has been overlooked by a majority of the general public.

You are scheduled later in the week to visit the facilities at CIP headquarters. I hope that many of you can take the time to also visit some of our experimental stations representing the major agroecological zones of the developing world where potatoes are grown.

The highland area around Lake Titicaca, between Peru and Bolivia, is where the cultivated potato originated. Peru is also the birthplace of several other tuber-root crops that are still used in a minor way, but these crops could increase in importance in the future due to population pressures. While you are here, there is opportunity to learn more about the future potential of these minor commodities.

We will do our best to help you have a successful conference. Please let us know if you have special interests that we may help you with while you are here in Peru.
